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Note: If submitted samples are non-homogeneous in nature, then sub-samples of the components will be analyzed and billed as separate layers. Because of equipment/measurement limitations, asbestos fiber content will be unable to be determined in some samples. Those samples determined to contain asbestos fibers, will have the following measurement percentage ranges (1% = 0-3%, 5% = 1-9%, 10% = 5-15%, 20% = 10-30%, 50% = 40-60%) as specified per EPA method 600/R-93/116. If samples are not collected by an AHERA Accredited Inspector, then the accuracy of results will be determined by the methodology and acuity of the sample collector
